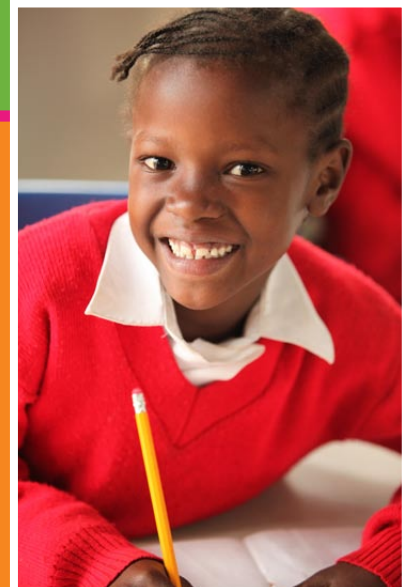


Joshua School Arusha

Hello all the friends and supporters of Joshua School Arusha (JSA)!!

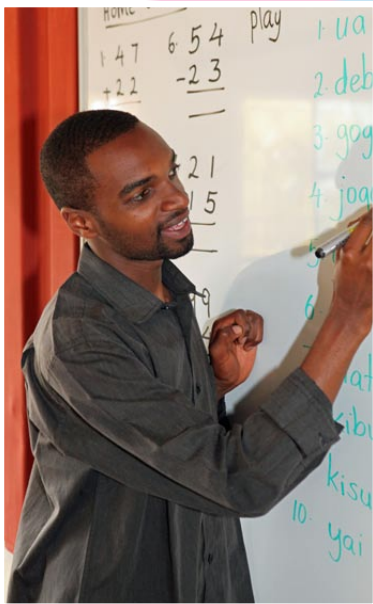
