Many thanks to all avid supporters and pray-ers. May this year be an even greater one for each of you in fulfilling God's wonderful purposes. In Tanzania, it's been an ongoing season of change:

Our usual leadership training module of 4 months has been postponed until August so curriculum and graduating criteria (like theses and research papers) can be completed. A 7-week course (beginning in February) will replace the standard one (see 'Leaders' training' section).

Teacher's College trainees are out in the field doing practicums for the next 5 months, also allowing for new approaches to be integrated into the curriculum (see 'Education Department' review).

The global economy resembles Revelation's 'roaring of the waves' with highs and lows (mostly lows) all over the place. This produces some interesting 'beached scenarios' for many missionaries!

Our business and agricultural departments are also undergoing significant review as we search for God's best, with the determination to assist as many Africans as possible into God's purposes for their lives (see 'Agriculture' and 'Business' sections).

Owen and Lois Wagener are now on furlough for 4 months in New Zealand, while others visit from the United States with the prospect of joining us in the future.

I have just completed a week-long head teachers 'caravan' -- head teachers from 8 Christian schools spent a week visiting each others' schools, sharing ideas and networking with each other. It was a fantastic experience to see 7 of these heads (who have trained at Joshua Teachers Training College) demonstrating such a solid grasp of Christian education and vision for the schools of this nation. In the process I was able to assess many of our trainee teachers who are now out in these schools doing their block teaching practice. I was very encouraged with the standard of teaching that I saw, not to mention the passion for the cause of Christian education that is steadily growing. Many of these schools are in remote and difficult areas, demanding strong vision and commitment.

On the home front we now have 2 classes of delightful preschoolers on our En Gedi campus. Teddy has settled quickly to the task of teaching here and her little group is making great progress. Having optimistically completed her Form 6 national exams, Celina is now back teaching her younger class. Our new preschool building is underway due to the generosity of a group in the UK. A huge thanks to Paul Crabtree for all his fundraising efforts on this project!

In Magugu, Goodbert is bringing new initiatives and enthusiasm to his role as head of the primary school. At the secondary school we are still struggling to get staff, but God has faithfully brought us a very experienced teacher with a strong faith! We are also very pleased that Allan and Sue Dow will return in May to work and support our Magugu school until the end of this year.
